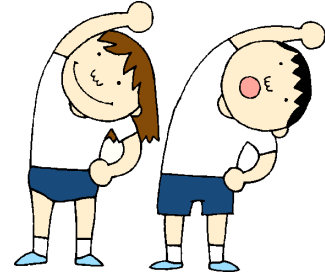

**Operation
Encompass**

Supporting children through key adults

Operation Encompass is a new innovative project in which schools in North Tyneside are participating, and which is run in partnership with North Tyneside Council and Northumbria Police. The project, which commences in June 2016, aims to support children who are affected by domestic abuse. Witnessing domestic abuse is really distressing for a child or young person, who often see the abuse, hear it from another room, see a parent's injuries or distress afterwards or can be physically hurt trying to stop the abuse. As a result, following any domestic abuse incident being reported to the police, the Police will make contact with Children's Social Care Front Door service who will then communicate relevant and necessary information to nominated school staff. This will ensure that the school is made aware at the earliest possible opportunity and can subsequently provide support to children in a way that means they feel safe and listened to. <http://www.operationencompass.org/>
