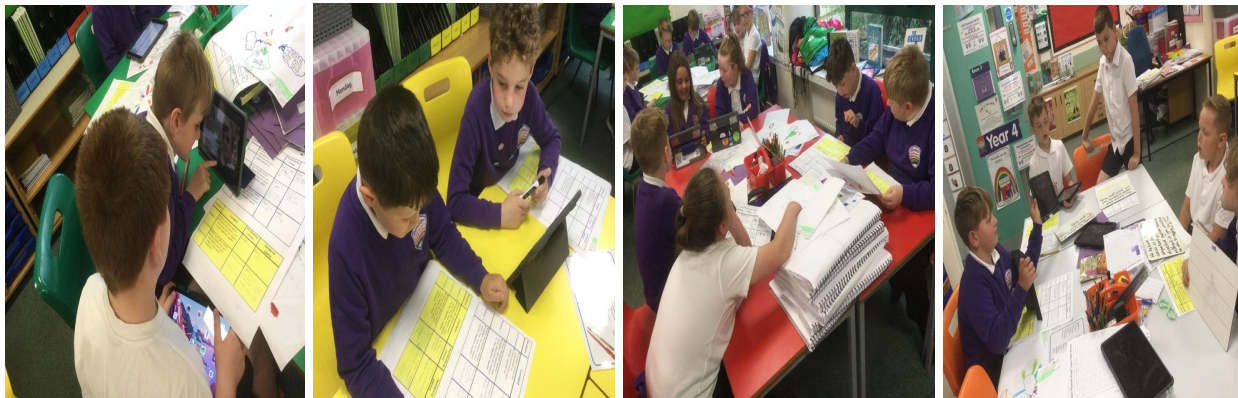


Year 4 Giraffes have been enjoying using their knowledge of Henri Matisse to create their own pieces of art.



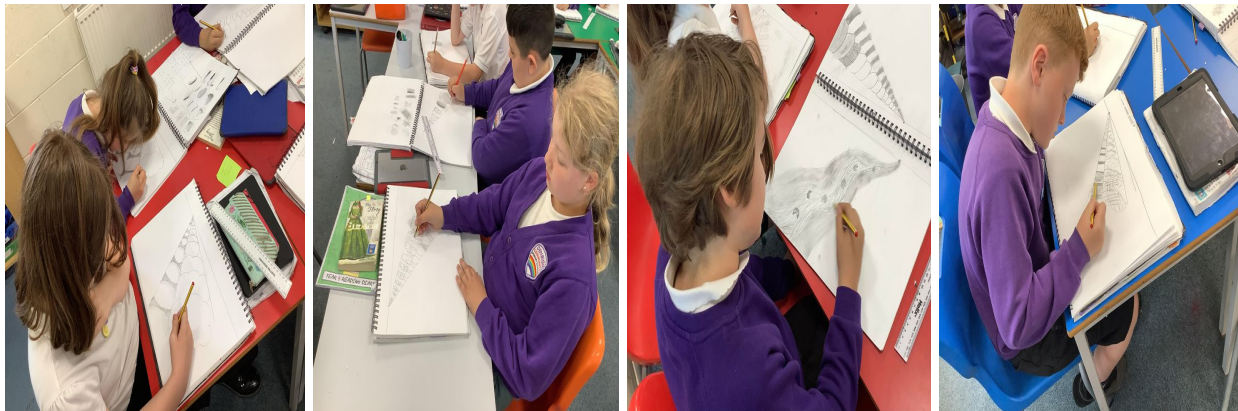
