2022 KS2 Impact Data

Disadvantaged pupils **attained** better than national expectations for disadvantaged pupils nationally at the Expected Standard in Reading, Writing, Maths, GPS and RWM combined.

Scaled **progress** Scores in Reading, Writing and Maths were above the national rates for disadvantaged pupils.

Internal data analysis demonstrated that the majority of disadvantaged pupils exceeded expected progress in KS1 and KS2 in Reading, Writing and Maths.

This information demonstrates an exceptional and sustained positive impact of pupil premium spending in our school.
