Children are required to attend school for 190 days each year

Attendance during one school year	equals days absent	which is approximately weeks absent	Which means this number of missed lessons
95%	9 days	2 weeks	45 lessons
90%	19 days	4 weeks	95 lessons
85%	29 days	6 weeks	145 lessons
80%	38 days	8 weeks	190 lessons
75%	48 days	10 weeks	240 lessons
70%	57 days	11.5 weeks	285 lessons
65%	67 days	13.5 weeks	335 lessons

How does your child's attendance compare with this target? Please remember that children who miss a lot of school achieve less Reminder: We do not authorise any holidays taken throughout term time. If you choose to take holidays they will be unauthorised and could lead to prosecution resulting in a fine from the Local Authority.
