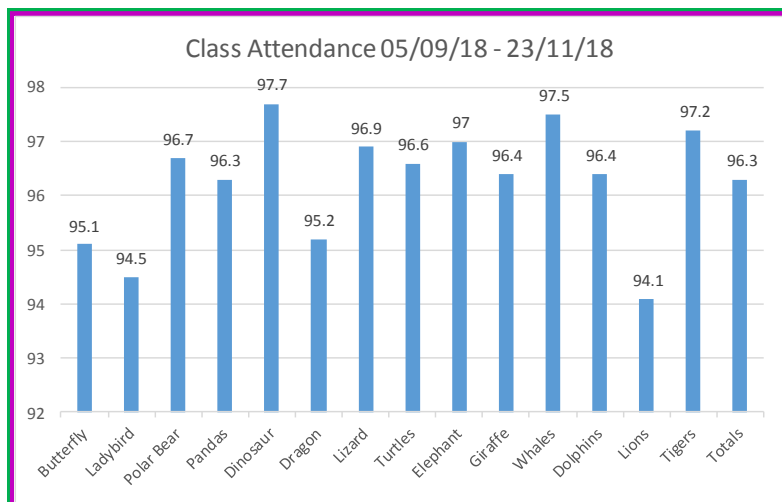
## Friday, 21st December Break up for Christmas Holiday
