

### **Publication of Governor's Details and Register of Interests – 2022/2023**

In the interests of transparency, all schools and academies should publish, including on their website, up to date details of the structure of the governing body and any committees, together with the names of their governors and their particular roles and responsibilities within that structure. This information is required for each governor who has served at any point over the past 12 months. They should also publish relevant business and pecuniary interests. This information must be published in a readily accessible form which means that the information should be on a webpage without the need to download or open a separate document.

Schools and academies should also publish an annual statement setting out the key issues that have been faced and addressed by the governing body over the last year, including an assessment of the impact of the governing body on the school.

### **Governing Body's Annual Statement**

The Issues faced and addressed by the Governing Body over the last year were:

#### **ACADEMY CONVERSION INVESTIGATION & DUE DILIGENCE:**

Governors investigated the risks and benefits of converting into a multi academy trust. This item was a standing item for discussion following feedback from the HT. It was also part of HTPM. As a result of this work, the school applied to convert with 4 other schools and gained DFE approval on 15th June 2023. This will have positive financial and educational benefits for the school and the wider area.

#### **COMPLIANCE STANDARD:**

Following tender presentations the Governing Body approved moving forward with The School Bus Compliance Standard for SEND, Safeguarding, Environment, Finance and Staffing. As a result, schools can clearly evidence and demonstrate robust processes in management of essential services for our school.

#### **SAFEGUARDING SUPPORT:**

The full governing body approved to move away from LA Safeguarding support to Clennell Educational Services service level agreement. As a result, the school has enhanced its systems for safeguarding and has access to a greater suite of training and resources in all areas of safeguarding. School has a nominated officer and this also enables supervision support to front line staff to ensure their well being.
