Week 1	s - adding <i>s</i> to words (plural of nouns and the third person singular of verbs)	cats dogs rocks
Week 2	es - adding <i>es</i> to words (plural of nouns and the third person singular of verbs)	catches foxes dishes matches
Week 3	er - adding <i>er</i> to adjectives	stronger quicker grander
Week 4	est - adding <i>est</i> to adjectives	quickest smartest brightest
Week 5	e-e split digraph	these theme complete
Week 6	er digraph	better sister under letter
